

Request for Proposal

The British Virgin Islands Ports Authority invites qualified companies/firms for:

Design and Engineering of an Administration Building at the site opposite of the container port (Block 2938B, Parcel 197), Tortola, British Virgin Islands.

SCOPE OF WORKS

The Design must consist of:

- 1) A multi-storey structure that is aesthetically pleasing and blend into the development of the surrounding areas. The building should utilize as much of the lot as legally possible and the overall design should accommodate perimeter landscaping.
- The structure must provide for five (5) floors, constructed of reinforced concrete and CMU/Block Walls. Engineered to withstand winds of 250 MPH. The Ground floor should be elevated to avoid flooding.
- 3) The floors are to be assigned as followed:
 - Ground Floor- Staff/Customer/ New Vehicle Parking
 - Second Floor- Customs, Immigration, Port Operations and Shipping Agents
 - Third Floor- Port Management
 - Fourth Floor- Lease Space
 - Fifth Floor- Lease Space
- 4) The design should provide for a 10ft service lane between the perimeter fence and the structure. A service side should be created with adequate access, capable of accommodating electrical and mechanical installations including emergency generating requirements.
- 5) The design should allow for a separate entrance and exit of traffic accessing the property, and the entrance and egress should flow smoothly and not further complicate the traffic systems existing in the area.

- 6) Restrooms should also be included for staff and customers.
- 7) Design should also detail engineering, mechanical, electrical, plumbing (MEP) and a fire suppression system. The building should provide adequate lighting (as far as practically possible) and ventilation into all office spaces and provide for fresh air exchanges to meet industry standard. A minimum of 2 elevators one being a slightly larger service elevator should be incorporated into the design and emergency stairs accommodated internally.
- 8) Design should adhere to local building codes.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PROPOSALS

Companies are required to furnish originals of the following:

- a) Certificates of Good Standing in respect of Social Security and all Taxes including Payroll Taxes and Property Taxes from:
 - (i) The Director of the Social Security Board; and
 - (ii) The Commissioner of Inland Revenue
