**Re:** **Primary V Examinations Update**

As the Primary V Examinations are quickly approaching, all principals are being reminded that the Valedictorian and Salutatorian for each respective school will be chosen by the Department, based on each student's examination score.

In addition, each student must meet the minimum requirement of attending his/her school for two (2) or more years. Principals are therefore required to submit a list of all students who were admitted to each school from the beginning of the 2011-2012 school year, and would have completed both classes four (4) and five (5) at that school.

Further to this, please note that the allocation of marks for Primary V is as follows:

Primary V Examinations -	70%
Continuous Assessments -	30%
